#### -Model T Moments-





The event will begin with a Thursday afternoon, October 16, 2025 arrival and check-in at the Pala Masa Resort (2001 Old Hwy 395, Fallbrook, Ca. (760-728-5881)). *A Boot Scootin' Ice Breaker around the Rusty Water Bar will occur at 5:00PM in the parking lot.* The fun filled three-day tour will begin on Friday, Oct 17 with a tour of the picturesque southern coast of California from Oceanside to Del Mar (or further if you like). Linking a string of charming beach communities, Historic Highway 101 hugs the Pacific Ocean and offers a taste of California's surf culture that can't be duplicated anywhere in the world.
